## **INSIGHTS**

In this verse (Beth) the Poet is asking how one can keep their ways PURE. When it comes to matters of "inner purity", scripturally the <u>MOTIVE of OUR HEARTS</u> is what is being weighed. That is why Proverbs 16:1-6 informs us that God examines our motive, no matter how a person's ways are seemingly pure in their own sight. The inner thoughts of our heart's echoes louder than what our minds conjurer to be deemed as 'good deeds' [Psalm 26:2].

It is for this reason that Jeremiah 17 warns us of our deceitful hearts, we cannot fully understand it for it carries secret motives and evil desires. Nonetheless, all hope is not lost for Word of God can and will discern it "exposing and judging the very thoughts and intentions of the heart." [Hebrews 4:12-13]. Afterwards the Holy Spirit steps in as the Refiner's Fire to purify and purge our impure motives and selfish desires so that we may desire the Truth in the inner being [Psalm 51:6-13].

That is why the Word of God's asks us to guard our hearts with ALL diligence since from there flow the springs of life [Proverbs 4:23]. This is can only be successful by seconding the poet's instruction "guarding it according to your Word." What does this look like? Studying the word of God, meditating upon it, apply it in our lives (obedience), which begins the transformation of the Heart and Mind. This is interpreted as to "treasure and store up" God's Word in our heart.

Now, this is not just a simple process rather is why with the promise of a New Covenant "a better covenant" that offers "better promises" God promises in Ezekiel 36:26-27 (Ezekiel 11:19-20)

Moreover, I will give you ANEWHEART and put a new spirit within you, and I will remove the HEARTOF STONE from your flesh and give you a HEARTOF FLESH. I will put my Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My ordinances and do them.

Seeking God wholeheartedly and His Kingdom will require a TRANSFORMATION OF THE HEART. You cannot walk in His statutes and keep His ordinances "treasure and store up" God's Word with the OLD HEART.

It's a matter of the heart; only when we receive a NEW HEART will we be obedient to God's commands and submit to His perfect Will for us.

And so, Jesus Christ teaches us through Beatitudes in Matthew 5:8 that "Blessed [anticipating God's presence, spiritually mature] <u>are the pure in heart</u> [those with integrity, moral courage, and godly character], <u>for they will see God</u>.
