VERSE: **n** Heth

The Lord is my portion; I have promised to keep Your words.

58 I sought Your favor with all my heart; Be merciful *and* gracious to me according to Your promise.

59 I considered my ways And turned my feet to [follow and obey] Your testimonies.

60 I hurried and did not delay To keep Your commandments.

61 he cords of the wicked have encircled *an∂* ensnared me, But I have not forgotten Your law.

62 At midnight I will rise to give thanks to You Because of Your righteous ordinances.

THEME

INSIGHTS

The Poet begins this stanza (**n** Heth) by attributing the Lord as his portion. In other versions of the Bible, "portion" is translated as "allotting inheritance/land [Luke 15:12]." Thus, the concept 'the Lord is my Portion' he means that he is their allotment, inheritance, treasure, and source of security [Numbers 18:20, Psalms 16:5-9]. In this case, He is enough to sustain and satisfy him, therefore he is committed to obeying His Word. The poet then seeks God's favour, and after self-reflection there is quick correction on his part; a demonstration of instant obedience [Isaiah 30:21].

He also alludes to being under pressure from the enemy's strikes, yet he remains focused on God's Word. Giving thanks always, not taking for granted God's judgments. Lastly, he makes a conscious decision, to stick by those who fear God. We are attracted to those who are like us, equally committed to obeying God's Word.

The Poet ends with a praiseworthy attitude; his perspective of God's love everywhere thus he desires to know more of God. [Philippians 4:4-9].
